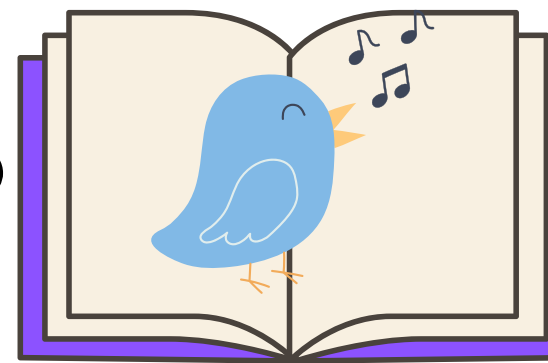




MARCH LIBRARY LEARNING COMMONS NEWS

BOOK CARE DURING SPRING BREAK

The students have been invited to check out library books for reading during spring break. When the students come for library next week we will talk about book care over spring break. The students will be reminded to take good care of their library books over the break and to return all of their books at the end of March.

Here are some tips for taking good care of books over spring break:

- Do not check books out and return all books if they are changing schools after spring break.
- Read and keep the books indoors so that they will not get wet or damaged.
- Do not bring library books when traveling. We may not be able to get the books back if they are left in another town or city.
- Keep the books in a dry and clean spot.
- Keep the books away from pets, food, slime, and art materials.
- Bring the books back after spring break so that other children can check them out.
