### PAC items:

Smita: BC School Food Guidelines. Guidelines have been in place for a long time. Last update was 2013 and now Health BC have designed a survey for future guidelines. Would the results affect PAC and our fundraising abilities? Discussion around equity for hot lunch and who can afford. Suggestion for a monthly "random" draw where families win hot lunch that month. Bring forward to the fall. Chika has kindly offered to have his company match. Kathleen suggests putting an option on order forms to donate extra. This will be brought forward for first fall meeting.

Smita: PAC social media acceptance months: having a "wonder wall" around a potential monthly theme (ie autism, down syndrome). PAC has a "wall" that we can start to re-use. Theme should fit into kindness, acceptance. This can include feedback from the students. Maybe we can use the walkathon as a soft re-opening. Include hot lunch dates as a visual.

Walkathon: chairs have the grand prize (Hoverboard) and would like to display it as an incentive. Also with a "thermometer". Tara has already been collecting pledge forms. Several parents have volunteered to help. Route has been set up and is basically a loop (includes railway path). Different lengths depending on grade. Event will be at 1 PM (parents volunteers asked to be present by 12.45) and run until 2.30. Volunteers can sign up to help via link on pledge form. Link to donate online is on PAC website. Staff appreciation lunch:

Money has been allocated from PAC. Need to decide on a date (end of June). Maybe in the future we could incorporate parents and staff. This year we will stick with just staff.

School wish list: will be discussed at staff meeting this Monday. Technology committee is looking at what needs upgrades.

School Garden: half of the classes are directly involved in a bed. They are making their way through the garden account but are okay for this year. Staff may ask that this cost be added to the school wish list in the future.
