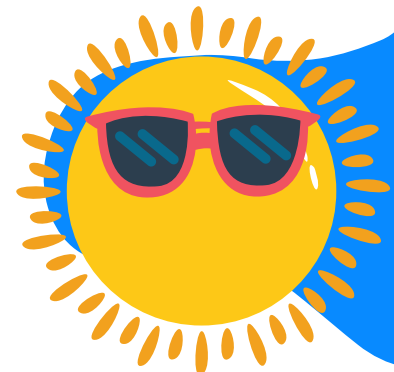




# SUMMER LIBRARY LEARNING COMMONS NEWS
