
Student illness

Community fridge


As you know we, now have a new snack fridge at our school. The fridge is funded through the Ministry of Education Feeding Futures Program.

Kindness Umbrella




Division 2 and Kindness to Place

History Bee Tournament Winner



Learning is magique in Division 16




If you ask a student in Division 16 to find the sum of all the numbers in the square, they will tell <u>you</u> without adding! Math magic.






Diversity and Multicultural Days

Ramadhan this year occurs from March 10 to April 10, 2024.

The Islamic calendar is based on the lunar calendar and therefore the moon must be sighted before Ramadhan can be declared officially. It is a significant month for observing Muslim families. In addition to other acts of supplication, Muslims refrain from food/drink from dawn to sunset.

April is Sikh Heritage Month

This month we learn about the traditions of the Sikh community and their significant impact on Canadian society.

April 10 - Eid-al-Fitr

Many Muslims in Canada celebrate Eid al-Fitr on the first day of Shawwal in the Islamic calendar. It marks the end of the monthlong fast of Ramadan and the start of a feast that lasts up to three days in some countries.

April 13 - Baisakhi or Vaisakhi

A harvest festival celebrated in India, mainly by the Sikh community.

April 22 -30 - **Pesach or Passover** (First Day is most significant)
Holiday that commemorates the Jewish liberation and escape
from Egypt.
