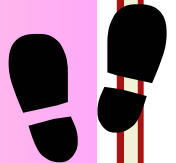

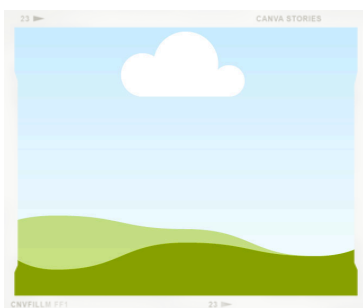

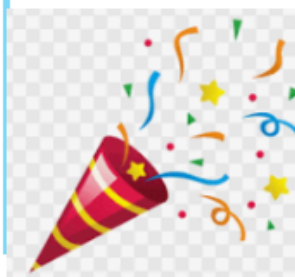

We are so proud of all our students participating in Track Attack practices and the meet events at Minoru. The weather was beautiful, there were many cheers, smiles and all out effort.

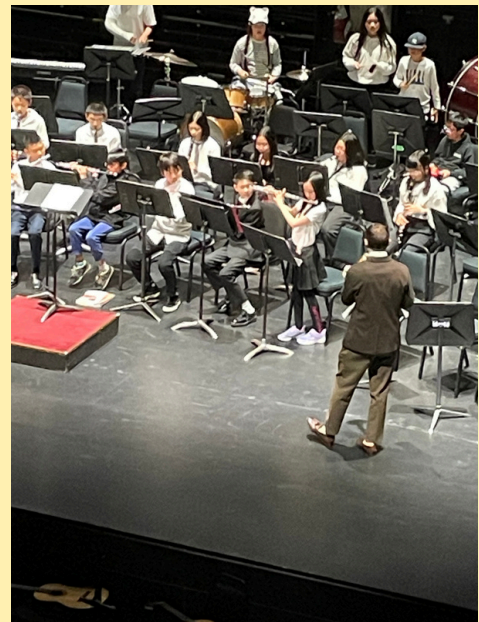
We also thank our staff for their tremendous work for many weeks prior to this event in organizing our students for the meet.

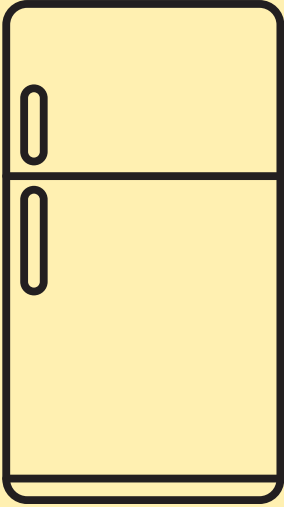
Music in the Schools 2024 in the Gateway Theatre
