








Diefenbaker School Story Kindness to self by Division 4

Acceptable Use of Student Personal Digital Devices:

Guidelines

Elementary Schools (K-7):

- Students should not have personal digital devices in their states possession during the school day unless permission is granted by the supervising staff for educational purposes. This includes during recess and lunch or while outside on the playground or on school property.
- It is recommended that students do not bring personal digital devices to school.

Secondary Schools (Grades 8-12):


- Students should not use personal digital devices during instructional time, unless permission is granted by the supervising staff for educational purposes.
