

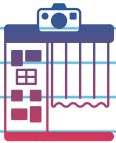

“Trick or Treat” Others with Respect.

Halloween should and needs to be fun; however, we need to be aware that celebrating Halloween needs to be fun for all. It is important to keep in mind that we need to be sensitive to groups that have been marginalized through mimicry and cultural appropriation during Halloween and other ‘dress up’ events.

It’s good to keep in mind that the following are NOT Costumes:

RACE (black face/brown face)

CULTURE (Indigenous regalia/dreadlocks)

RELIGIOUS FAITH (religious figures/gods/saints/gurus/hijab)

GENDER (gender switching for humour or to mock)

TRAUMA (hangman’s noose/weapons)

Please, do not send your children with masks or accessories that are meant to represent weapons or that feature blood/gore. This is frightening for younger students and we want all students to enjoy the excitement of the day.

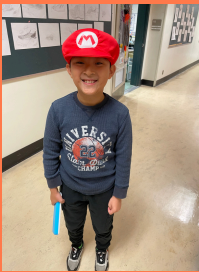
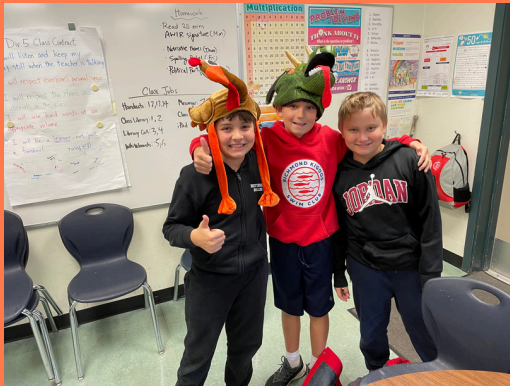

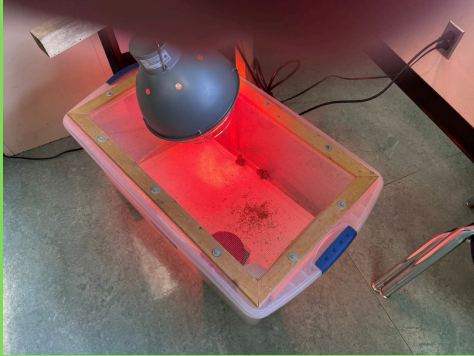
Garry Point Fun Run 2024
