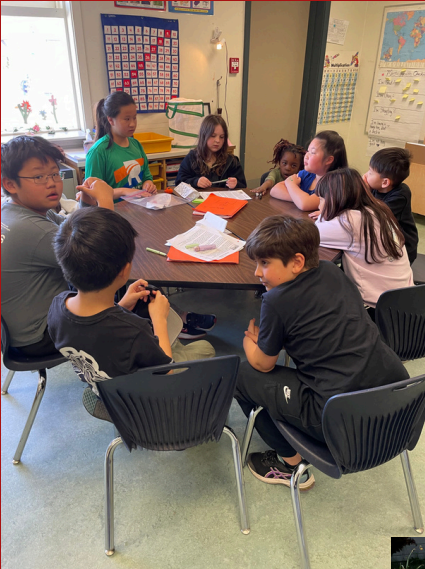

Parking in the drop-off zone - stay in your vehicles
