

Keeping our community healthy

Parking reminder: Staff parking is for STAFF ONLY at all times.

Staff parking is for staff only. Please, do not park in the staff back parking lot. Also, please do not park on the road leading to the staff parking lot. Parents and caregivers are asked to park in the drop off area. If the area is full, then please park on the **neighbourhood streets.** Thank you for keeping the parking lot area safe for our children.

Message from our School Liaison officers to everyone:

Slow down at all times in the school zone and parking lots.



Make sure your children are buckled up with safety seat belts at all times.

Parking in the drop-off zone - stay in your vehicles

This is a reminder to stay in your vehicles at all times when parking in the drop off zone while dropping off or picking up your children. It is unsafe to leave your cars unattended and slows down the drop off time for everyone. If you need to walk your children to the classroom, please park your car on the nearby street and walk together.

Parking for people with disabilities in the drop off zone

Be mindful of the parking spot for people with disabilities. Stop and let them enter or leave their vehicle when parked.
